

## Commission Holidays in 2022 and how to add them to your Outlook calendar

In 2022 there will be 17 public holidays when the Brussels Commission offices will be closed (even though permanence will be allowed or requested for certain days). These holidays have been determined in [C\(2021\) 11](#).

They are:

- 14 April, Maundy Thursday
- 15 April, Good Friday
- 18 April, Easter Monday
- 9 May, Monday, Anniversary of the Declaration by President Schuman in 1950
- 26 May, Thursday, Ascension Day
- 27 May, Friday, the day after Ascension Day
- 6 June, Whit Monday
- 21 July, Thursday, Belgian National Holiday
- 15 August, Monday, Assumption
- 1 November, Monday, All Saints' Day
- 2 November, Tuesday, All Souls' Day
- 23 December to 30 December, 6 end-of-year days.
